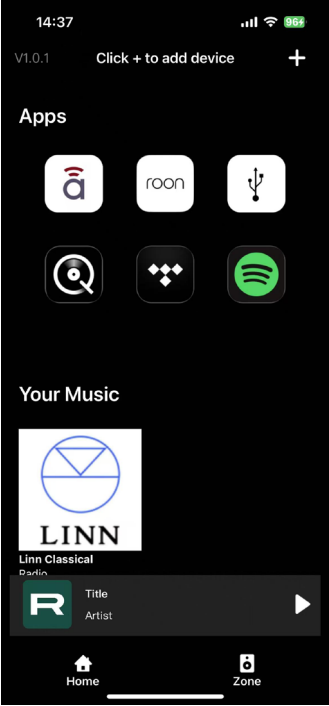
Google Chromecast Audio (Cast Lite) Release

Google Chromecast Audio (Cast Lite) allows you to add your RAS-5000 or S14 as a Google Cast Audio device directly in the Rotel streamer app, eliminating the need to set it up through the Google Home app. This simplifies both the setup process and device control.

Activating this feature requires a simple three-step update process:

1. Automatic OTA Update – Your unit will automatically begin updating over the air (OTA).
2. Rotel App Update – Update the Rotel Streamer app via the App Store or Google Play Store.
2. Software Version Check – Verify that both your device and Rotel app software versions match those listed in the table below.

This feature allows you to add your RAS-5000 as a Google Cast Audio device directly in the Rotel streamer app instead of using the Google Home app. Note: The Rotel streamer app that supports this feature will be available on the App store and Google Play store on March 27, 2025. Implemented Airable Preset to save and play your favorite Internet Radio Stations via the PRESET button on the remote control with a push-hold to save and push to recall. Implemented USB audio file metadata display including album artwork, title, artist, and album name when playing audio from a USB Flash Drive. Implemented Max Volume to limit the maximum volume level of the unit to limit loudness level. This is helpful to avoid possible damage or too loud output due to accidental volume increases via the App, remote control or front panel. Optimized the software to eliminate unexpected output distortion when playing streaming audio (example from TIDAL) music. Fixed a bug where source changes to Streaming with volume reset occurred randomly. Fixed a bug where the USB file tree may not display properly in the USB menu in the Rotel streamer app. Other minor bug fixes.
